- Travel

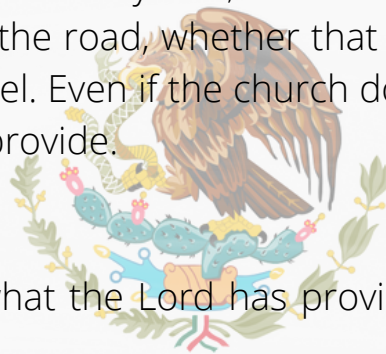

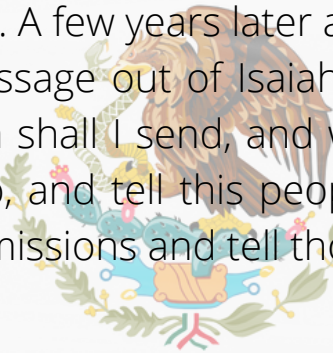
